3. Opening Remarks - Dr. Philip Rubin

This Committee will be providing an update and a report from three different areas promoting research and innovation.

4. Research Updates and Accomplishments -

Department of Marine Sciences, UConn, Avery Point

Annemarie Seifert, Ph.D. – Campus Director, UConn Avery Point

J. Evan Ward, Ph.D. – Professor/Department Head – Marine Sciences

James O'Donnell, Ph.D. - Executive Director, CT Institute for Resilience & Climate Adaptation (CIRCA)

Dr. Seifert highlighted all of the programs related to innovation, entrepreneurship and economic development at Avery Point. Dr. J. Evan Ward spoke on the background and current research capacity of the Department of Marine Sciences and its work in climate science and climate adjacent areas. Dr. Jim O'Donnell discussed CIRCA performed research on climate change and sea level rise in Connecticut as well as the history and structure of CIRCA. A review of Resilient Connecticut, a project coordinated with CIRCA involving other CT agencies.

5. Innovation Partnership Building Programs & Partnerships in Climate Adjacent Areas – Pamir Alpay, Ph.D. – Executive Director, Innovation Partnership Building

Dr. Pamir Alpay gave a broad overview of the Innovation Partnership Building capabilities and discussed the goals and Tech Park initiatives. Dr. Alpay also discussed the current and ongoing efforts in relation to clean energy resilience and sustainability by IPB. An overview of recent successes and partnerships was also offered.

6. Technology Incubation Program (TIP) Updates

Mostafa Analoui, Ph.D. – Executive Director, Venture Development Vivek Ramakrishnan, Ph.D. – Director, Venture Development Paul Parker – Director, TIP

Dr. Mostafa Analoui offered quick recap of recent developments and highlights of the Technology Incubation Program and gave an overview of TIP and how they support innovators of the University and State. He introduced Paul Parker, who discussed the three TIP locations and shared data on their current statuses and successes. Dr. Analoui discussed TIP Digital in Stamford and the Data Science Initiative and its inception and current successes. Dr. Vivek Ramakrishnan spoke on Venture Development and the topline and current activities of the UConn startups.
