4) Report from previous Trustee-Administration-Faculty-Student (TAFS) Meeting

Vice-Chair Gouin shared a summary of the previous TAFS meeting held in December 2021 which included discussions around food insecurity.

5) Affirmative Action in Admissions: Preparing UConn for the U.S. Supreme Court Decisions

Vice President for Enrollment, Planning and Management Nathan Fuerst and UConn Health Chief Diversity Officer Jeffrey Hines shared a presentation on the two cases currently pending with the Supreme Court; Students for Fair Admissions vs. Harvard/UNC, related to using race in higher education admissions processes.

6) Open Discussion and Identification of Agenda Items for Next Meeting

There was a general discussion regarding the potential impacts of the pending Supreme Court decision and how it might impact UConn's current practices of individual holistic review of applications. There is a planning group who meets monthly to monitor the progress of the Supreme Court cases and continue to educate the UConn community on potential outcomes to prepare for a final decision.

Chair Gouin thanked all in attendance for their participation in the discussion, and asked Committee Members to reach out with suggestions for future agenda items.
