Regarding funding, faculty received \$322 million in new awards between UConn and UConn Health; \$85 million through the School of Medicine; \$72 million through the School of Engineering; and \$80 million through the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.

4. Engagement at UConn Stamford, Jennifer Orlikoff, Ph.D., Campus Dean and Chief of Administration Officer

Dean Orlikoff discussed the Stamford Campus' vision and academic outlook, highlighting components of the student population, student organizations, academic programs, and career services.

5. Engagement at UConn Waterbury, Fumiko Hoeft, MD, Ph.D., Campus Dean and Chief of Administration Officer

Dr. Hoeft highlighted the Waterbury Campus' immediate proximity to a racially and ethnically diverse community population and the Campus' engagement priorities, academic and research growth, and fundraising priorities.
